Recipe from Christa's Crazy Kitchen

Frosty Orange Dream Squares

50 vanilla wafers, finely crushed (about $1\frac{1}{2}$ cups)

 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ stick) butter, melted

2 cups cold milk

2 pkg (4 serving size each) jello vanilla instant pudding

8 oz cool whip, thawed, divided 2 cups orange sherbet, softened

Mix wafer crumbs and butter. Press firmly onto bottom of pan; set aside until ready to use. Add milk to dry pudding mixes in medium bowl. Beat with wire whisk 2 min. or until well blended. Gently stir in half of the cool whip; spoon evenly over crust. Refrigerate 10 minutes Add remaining cool whip to sherbet; stir with wire whisk until well blended. Spoon evenly over pudding layer; cover. Freeze at least 3 hours. Store leftover dessert in freezer. *I use a cup more sherbet than the recipe calls for when I make it.
